Several organisms may issue certifications. For French levels, we recommend the levels of the French Federation of Underwater Studies and Sports (FFESSM) which are internationally recognized through the World Confederation of Underwater Activities (CMAS), for this you will need to have a valid license or subscribe one in our center. However, you have the option of an unlicensed patent with a certification established by the ANMP. For other international levels, we also issue PADI and SSI certificates.

The licence can be purchased or renewed at our diving center. You also have the option of taking individual supplementary insurance.

# RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Apart from the first dive, every diver must present their CMAS card (or diving diploma) and a medical certificate of no contraindication to the practice of diving of less than a year old.
  - For children's courses and N4 training or as part of a derogation, the medical certificate must be issued by a federal doctor. In the absence of a **federal doctor**, it can be done by a **medical graduate in underwater medicine or sports**.  
For courses N1, N2 and N3 the medical certificate can be established by a general practitioner.
  - Each diver is responsible for the equipment loaned or rented by the centre. In case of damage or loss, the equipment must be refunded or replaced at its cost price.
  - The deposit paid for a registration will not be returned in case of withdrawal.
  - In any event, no reimbursement may be made for reasons other than medical reasons.
  - Any lost belt will be **charged 15 € + 10 € per kilo**
  - The center will not be liable for any compensation in case of impossibility to go out at sea for safety reasons related to bad weather, only the dives carried out will be due.
  - The centre manager or the pilot can change the choice of site and depth at any time according to the weather conditions or the level of practice of the participants.
  - The rates of the services do not take into account federal supplies: Adult License, Child License, CMAS/FFESSM Card, Passport and Diving Book. You have the possibility to take out additional individual insurance in our centre.
  - To attest to their level of practice, all divers, if necessary, the group leader, must present their log book and specify to the leader all known problems likely to have consequences in diving.
  - All technical or exploration dives beyond 20 m must be preceded by one or more rehabilitation dives. Divers who do not wish to perform this rehabilitation must then prove that they regularly dive at these depths through their dive log book.
  - Whatever their level, divers who have not practiced this activity for more than a year must make a dive in 0 and 20 m and without dec stop
  - Dives beyond 20m and wreck dives are dives with a higher risk of accident. This risk is mainly due to the depth, the cold, the visibility conditions but also the physical condition and the actual level of practice of the participants.
  - For safety and accident prevention reasons related to desaturation:
    - We recommend that only one dive be carried out beyond 30 m per 24:00 and in cases where there is a beyond 30 m requiring desaturation stops then the surface interval must be as large as possible between the first and the second dive.
    - When a diver is required to perform two laps in the same dive beyond 30 m he is then limited to only one dive per day.
    - Consecutive dives and successive dives with an interval less than 2h00 are not allowed after a dive beyond 30m.
  - **Specific conditions for supervisors under the group tariff:**
    - Free dives for supervisors E3 minimum in teaching dives with a ratio of 1 supervising for 3 students minimum in zone 0-20 m and 2 students minimum in zone 20-40m.
    - The rental of the equipment remains due in particular the rental and the inflation of the tanks which will be charged 6 € per supervisor and per dive (3 € if inflation only)
    - **When this ratio is not respected the dives of the supervisors will be charged 50% cheaper than the group rate.**
- In the event that we perform the function of DP, all dives are increased by 2 €**

By accepting this regulation, the club president undertakes to inform its members of the risks associated with diving. It ensures that the actual level of practice of its members and their physical condition allows to practice the activities required at the host structure and under the responsibility of its director of diving and this regardless of the level of practice and teaching of the pilot of the boat.
